


## The Mount School, York

## HOW TO GET THERE



To avoid York's busy and congested city centre, visitors are advised to approach the Mount School via either the A1036 (from the south) or the A59 (from the north-west). Both roads can be reached easily from the encircling by-passes (A1237 and A64) as shown on the accompanying map.

If travelling by the A1036, leave the racecourse on the right and turn left into Dalton Terrace at the traffic-lights at the top of the rise. To reach the Visitors' Car Park, enter Driffield Terrace (first turning on the left) and turn right at the end of it.

If travelling by the A59, from the roundabout on the outer bypass (A1237) follow the signs to the City Centre. After crossing the steel-arched railway bridge, turn right into Dalton Terrace and, after passing the front of the School, right again into Driffield Terrace.





From the York Racecourse and Tadcaster Road, pass the Elm Bank Hotel on your left and the Elm Bank Lodge on your right then continue straight up Love Lane. Do not follow the road which bends to the right (Driffield Terrace). Parents can then use Car Park No. 3 which is off Driffield Terrace at the end of Love Lane. Car Park No. 3 is 80 metres up Love Lane on the right hand side, identified by 2 stone bollards at the entrance.

From Car Park No. 3 follow the signs for The Mount School Sports Hall - The Mount Fitness Suite. Walk across the Tennis Courts heading towards a gate in the middle of the opposite end. Follow path to your right and down some steps. Go to the right, keeping the Main School Building on your right-hand side. Walk across Playground heading towards the furthest point on the left of the Main Building. Walk up the steps to the Pool Entrance.
